# Continuing Education at the Royal Conservatoire of Scotland

## One-to-One Lessons

Continuing Education is offered on a part-time basis and in the form of one-toone tuition to meet the needs of individual students. Each unit of study consists of 30 minutes one-to-one tuition, over 27 weeks. The Continuing Education fee covers the cost of delivering one-to-one lessons only, although Continuing Education students may also benefit from other resources and opportunities (see below).

### Access to Library

As well as lessons, students on Continuing Education have the added benefit of access to the RCS library.

#### Access to Practice Rooms

Continuing Education students should practise at home as much as possible, since practice rooms are prioritized for full-time RCS students.

### Audition and Fees

Audition for entry to the Continuing Education course takes 30 minutes in total in front of a panel of from Conservatoire staff. Candidates are required to play two contrasting pieces (scales may be required) and there is a short interview. There are no written papers required. The Conservatoire reserves the right not to audition applicants in discipline areas that are over-subscribed.

Continuing Education does not lead to entry to any other Conservatoire programme of study (e.g BMus or MMus) nor does it lead to a qualification.

The audition / processing fee is £35 which must be included at time of application.

The fees for Continuing Education for Session 2025/26 are £2,095 (Scottish and RUK) and £3,344 (International) per unit for the academic year.
