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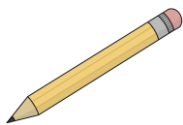
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About this guide

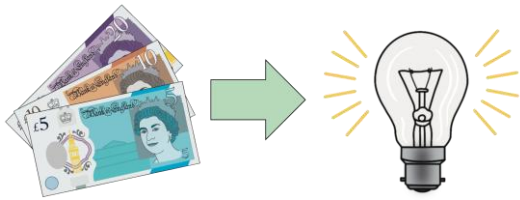

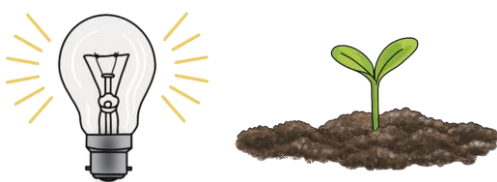
What is the Seed Fund?



A **Seed Fund** is money to help start a new idea and let it grow.

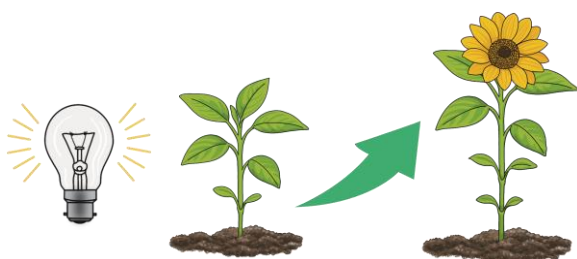


The Seed Fund gives small amounts of money. This money is called **seed funding**.

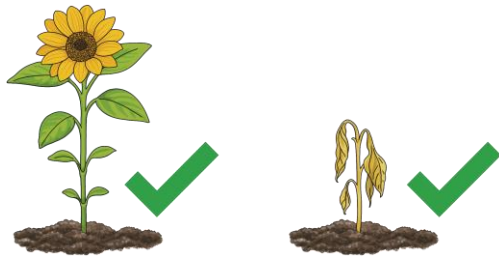


The money can help you:

- start a new creative idea, or



- grow an idea you already started



The Seed Fund is for trying things out. It is okay if your idea changes. It is okay if your idea does not work as planned.

The Seed Fund is run by **Innovation Studio.**

Innovation Studio is part of the Royal Conservatoire of Scotland, or RCS.

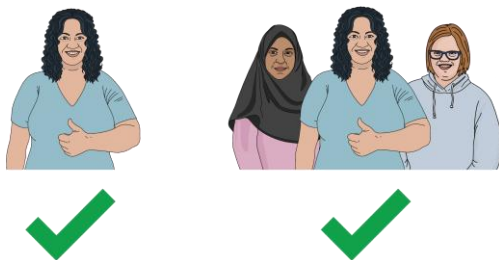


Innovation Studio helps students and staff to try new creative ideas.

Who can apply?



- You must be an RCS student or staff member.



- You can apply on your own or with others.



- Your project does not have to be about the subject you are studying.



- Your project **cannot** be part of your graded coursework.

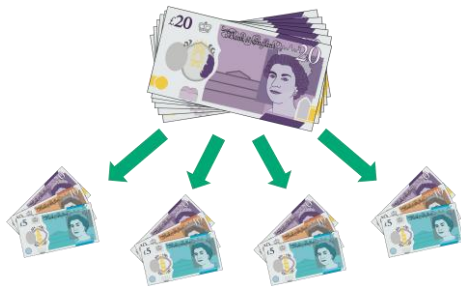


- You can apply if you are on a Student or Visitor visa. But you must follow Home Office rules.

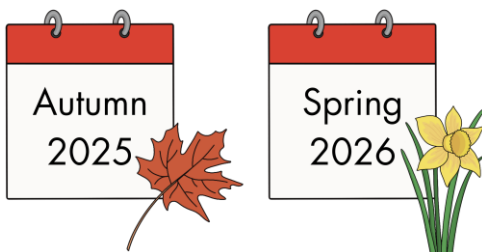


- There are special rules if you are RCS staff.

How much money can I ask for?



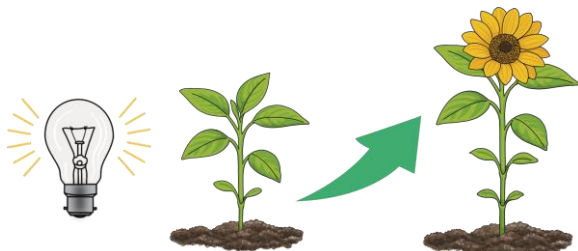
We will share out **£20,000** in each round.



There are 2 rounds this school year. One in autumn 2025, and one in spring 2026.

You can apply for:

- Up to **£1000** – for very early ideas
- Up to **£4000** – for ideas you already started and need more money to develop further



Access costs



You can ask for extra money for access needs.



This money helps you or your team take part fully in your project. For example, you could ask for BSL interpretation for a Deaf artist.



Access costs are paid on top of your Seed Fund award.

Timeline

Autumn 2025 – Round 1



- Seed Fund opens:
Wednesday 1st October 2025



- Application deadline: **5pm on Monday 3rd November 2025**



- We will email you our decision within 6 weeks after the deadline



- You must finish your project within 12 months after it starts. For example, if your project starts in March 2025, you must finish it by March 2026

Spring 2026 – Round 2



- Seed Fund opens: **Tuesday 28th April 2026**



- Application deadline: **5pm on Monday 1st June 2026**



- We will email you our decision within 6 weeks after the deadline

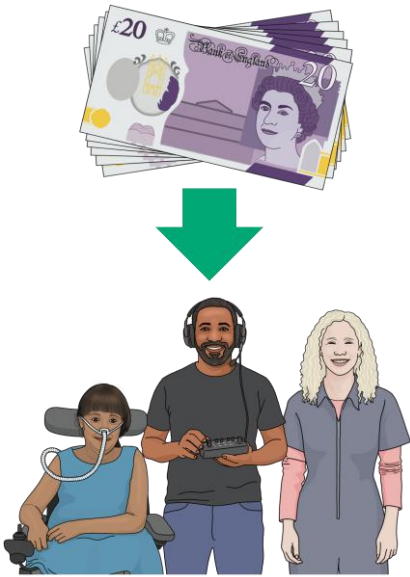


- You must finish your project within 12 months after it starts. For example, if your project starts in June 2026, you must finish it by June 2027

Fair Access



Innovation Studio wants to make the arts fairer for everyone.



We will give **at least half of the funding** to projects led by people who face barriers.



Barriers are things that make it harder for some people to get chances or take part.



We explain who we mean by people who face barriers in **Common Questions**.

How to Apply



You must apply online by the deadline.



We cannot take late applications.

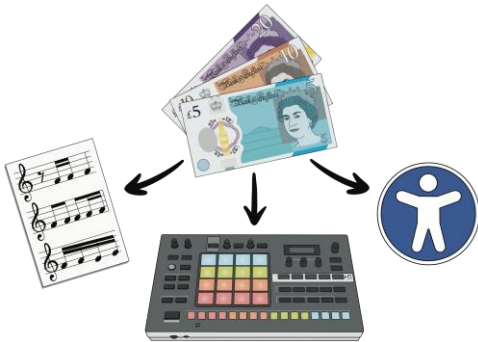

Budget



You must include a **budget** when you apply.



A budget is a list of what you will spend money on in your project.

Recording your project



You must keep a record of what happens in your project. This could be photos, film, or short notes.



We will give you **£250 extra** to help with this.

Sharing your work



At the end, you must also **share your project**.



This could be a short talk, or a one to one meeting with the Innovation Studio team.



You must also fill in an evaluation form.
